Eleanore Duggan is a talented singer/songwriter and instrumental composer with a wealth of performance experience. In 2004, she won a national songwriting competition through Celador Productions for Channel 4, to have a track on Kylie Minogue's next album. She takes inspiration from an eclectic range of musical styles, including pop, contemporary r'n'b, soul, hip hop, indie, rock, jazz and folk. She has also played as the support act for jazz singer, Clare Teal.

Keen to diversify and extend her musical experience, in the Autumn of 2008, Eleanore will be appearing in the lead female role in "The Baker's Wife" (a musical by Stephen Schwartz & Joseph Stein) at the Electric Theatre in Guildford.

Eleanore currently has a single release: "Feels so Good" (E.Duggan/C.Clarke) available to buy as a download on iTunes, Tunetribes and Juno. She is also working hard to complete production on her first album, with a release planned for the end of 2008. A tour will follow.

SB Dance originally commissioned Eleanore in 2006, with a brief to compose a forty minute orchestral piece in four movements; a marriage of both Indian and Western influenced music, which Eleanore completed in two and a half months. The original version of "asmâkam - the quest" was showcased in June 2006 at Cranleigh Arts Centre in Surrey and was a great success. Since then Eleanore has reworked some of the piece and plans to develop the work further in the future in readiness for a wider audience and as an album release.
